



Dell Diamond Ballpark

Round Rock, Texas

7,500 seat AA Minor League Ballpark includes corporate suites, player locker rooms, press facilities, team offices and a 9,500 sq.ft. conference center

Pro Player Stadium (formerly Joe Robbie Stadium)

Miami, Florida

75,000 seat open stadium for both football and baseball with 250 Suites and a 150,000 sq. ft. lounge/club for the boxes. A unique aspect of this stadium is that ventilation is provided for the "open" 10,000 seat premium area.

Texas Stadium

Irving, Texas

65,000 seat stadium with an open dome area over the playing field. Athletic facilities include three separate locker room areas, each with infirmary, training and meeting rooms.

Amenities include the 13,000 sq. ft. Stadium Club, 188 Private Circle Suites located on two levels, plus 118 Crown Suite Skyboxes added in 1985 and 64 completely furnished Crown Suites added in 1993, both of which are on the upper deck. In addition, 12 Platinum Suites each provide seating for 24 people.

Support facilities include Administrative offices, public infirmary, approximately 50 concessions (both general and food storage), employee locker rooms, and service areas. Surface parking is provided for 15,000 cars.

Two computer controlled 38' x 28' Diamond Vision screens are suspended from the roof trusses. Also controlled from the Press box are the two 38' x 28' scoreboards.
